This is done by running game-invitational hands through Stayman first, and then rebidding 2NT. Four Suit Transfer Bids - Bridge Guys Four Suit Transfer Bids . These Transfer Bids were popular during the 1980s and were used by many bridge players. This is the extended version of the Jacoby Transfer after an opening of 1 No Trump by the responder to transfer to all four suits. The range of the No Trump opening becomes irrelevant as long as the partnership agreement raises or lowers the expected number of values to be held by the responder for game contracts. Four Suit Transfers - Omaha Bridge A fairly common convention these days is that called Four Suit Transfers. The name is indicative of what it allows---- after a 1NT opening bid responder has the ability to transfer to any one of the four suits. This makes it an extended version of Jacoby transfers bids in that responder is also able to transfer to either minor suit.

In all cases, for single-suited transfers, at least 6 cards in a minor is needed, and if the hand is not weak, denies a 4-card major.

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
